Douglas, Austen BioInnovation Institute in Akron, will lead panelists Andreas Fibig, Bayer Schering Pharma AG; Loïc Maurel, Exonhit Therapeutics; and Olaf G. Wilhelm, WILEX AG in a discussion of how drug development firms can succeed in the emerging personalized healthcare regime.</p>
